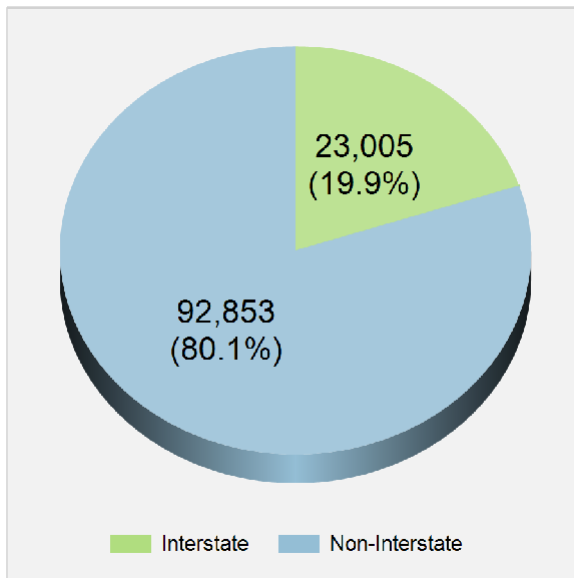

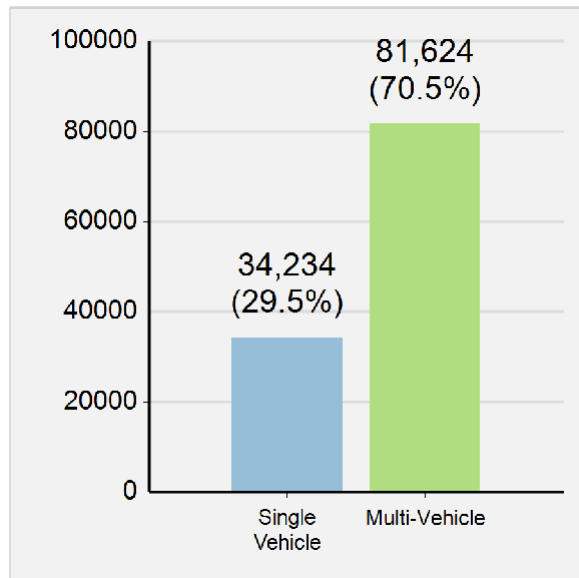

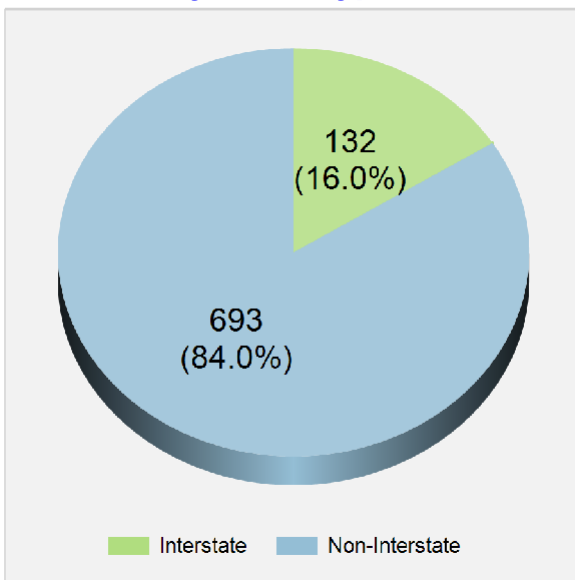

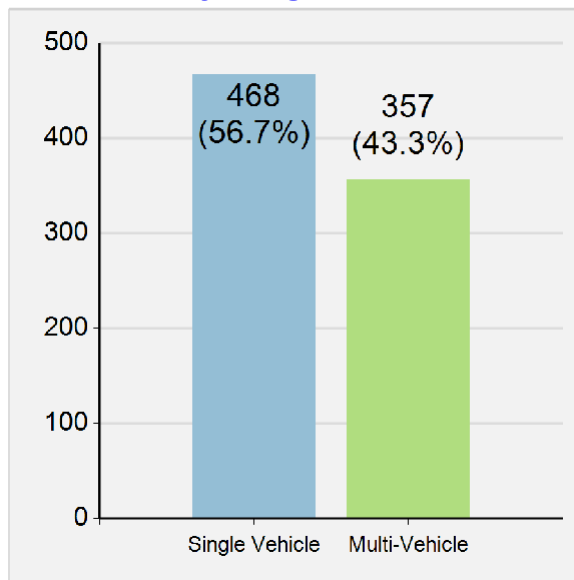

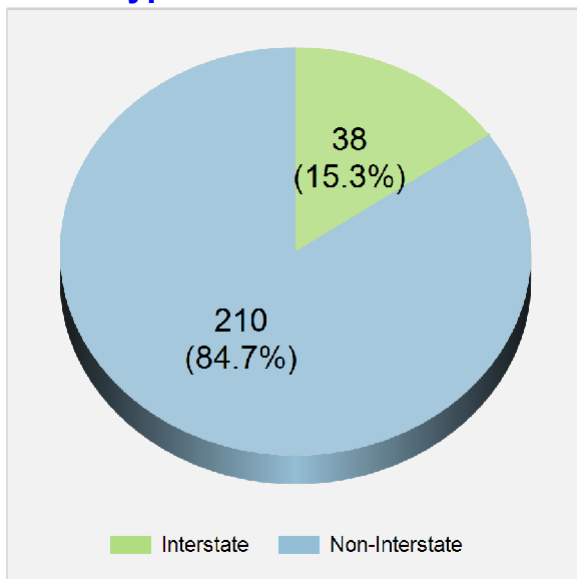

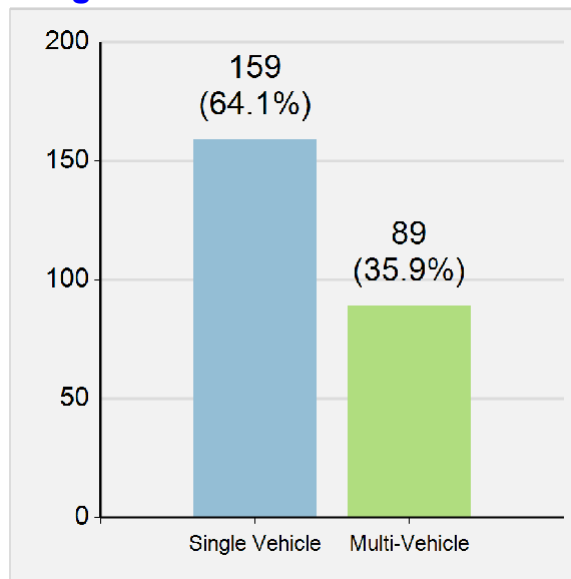

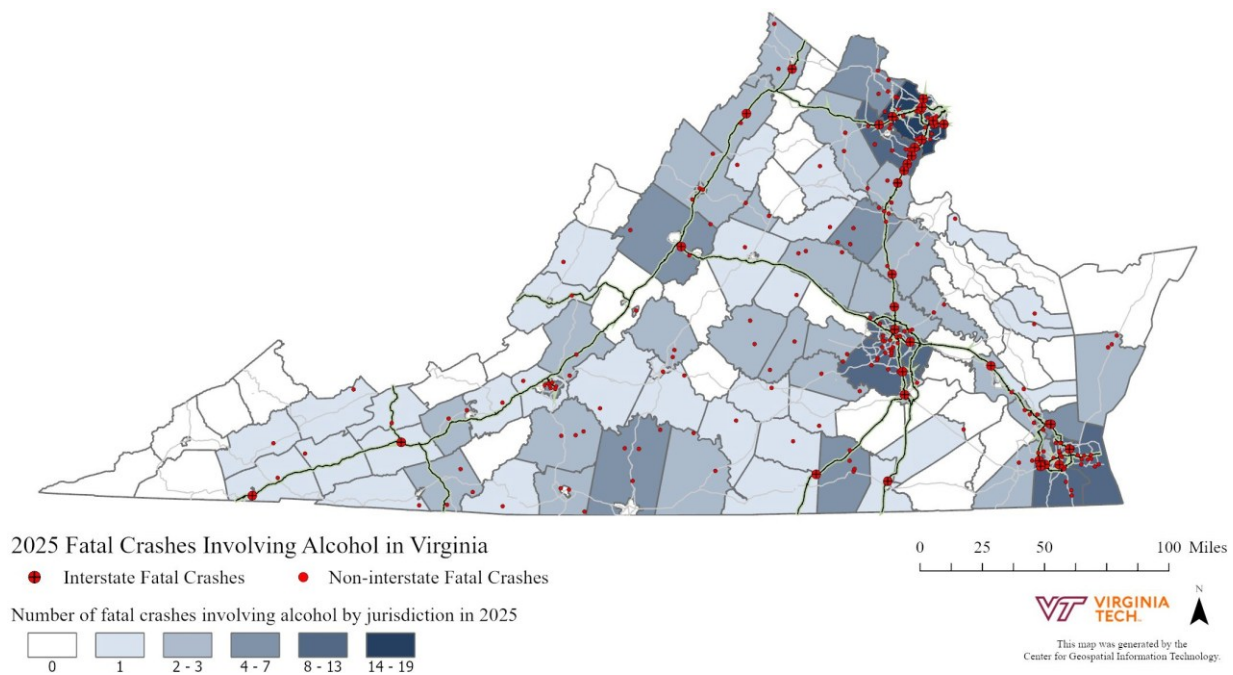

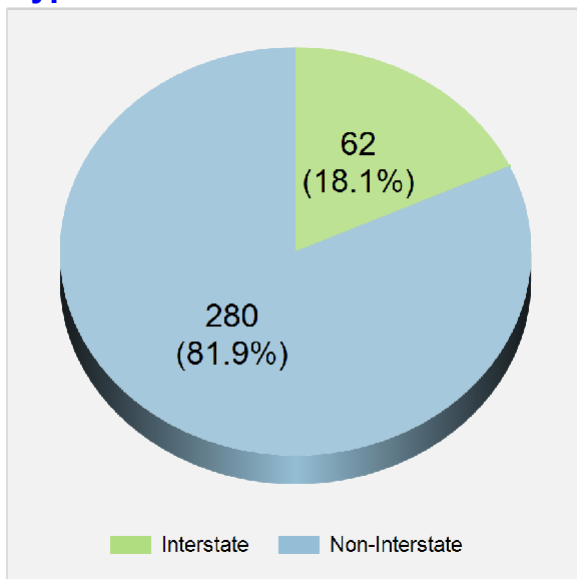

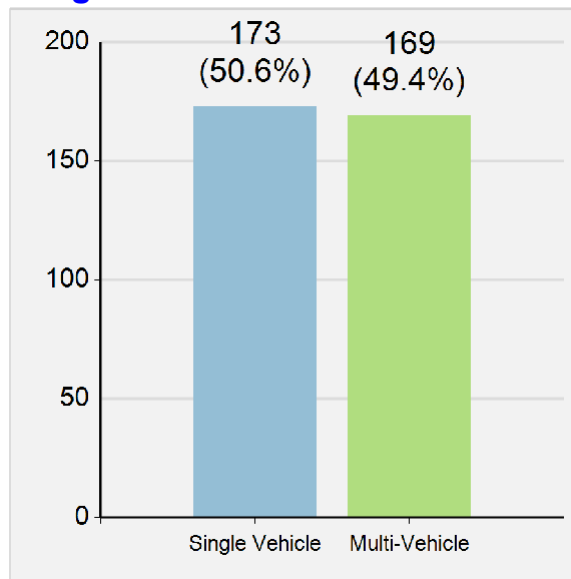

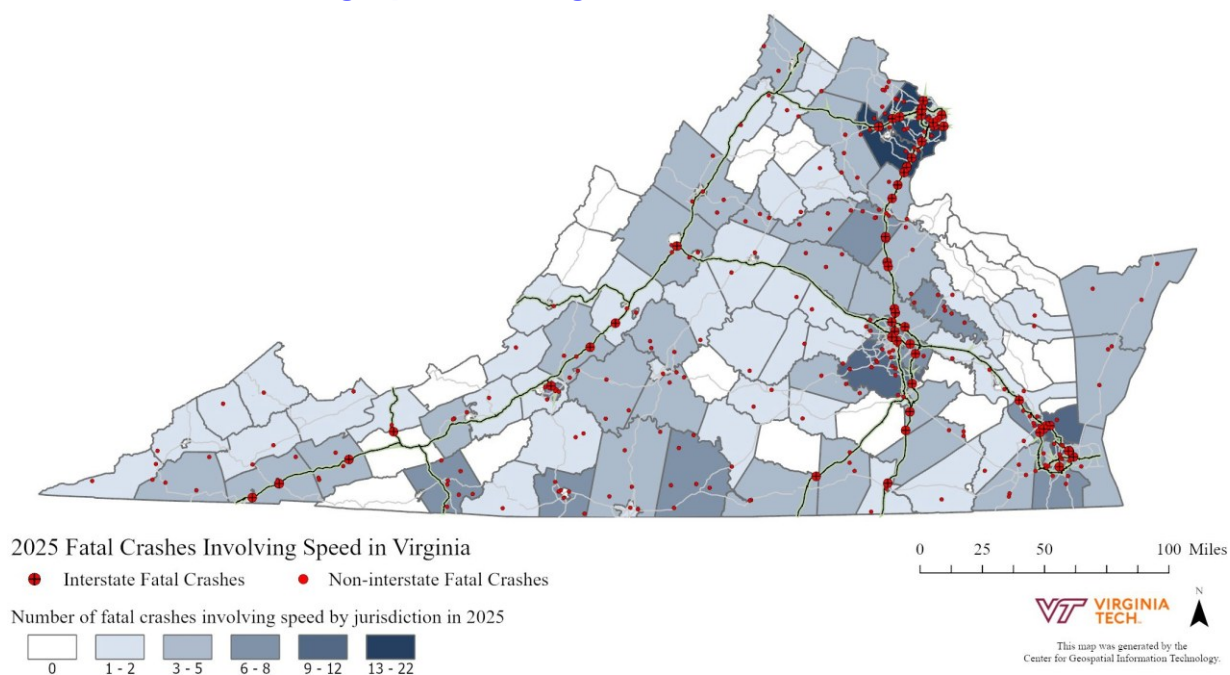

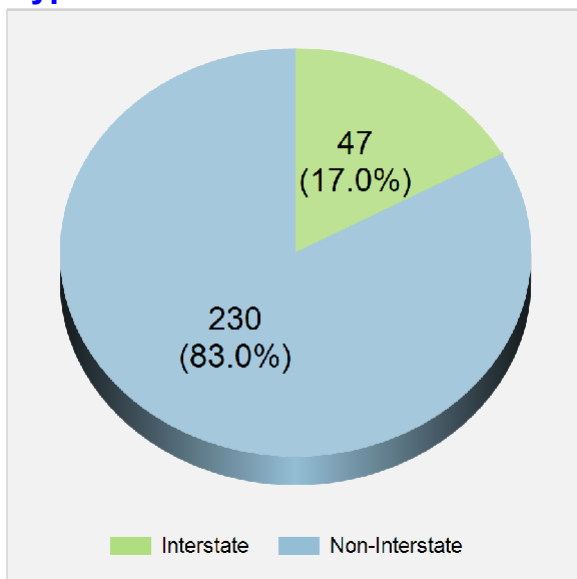

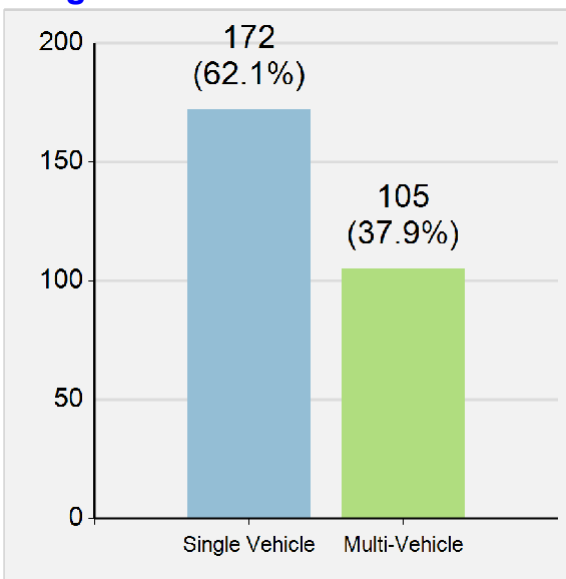

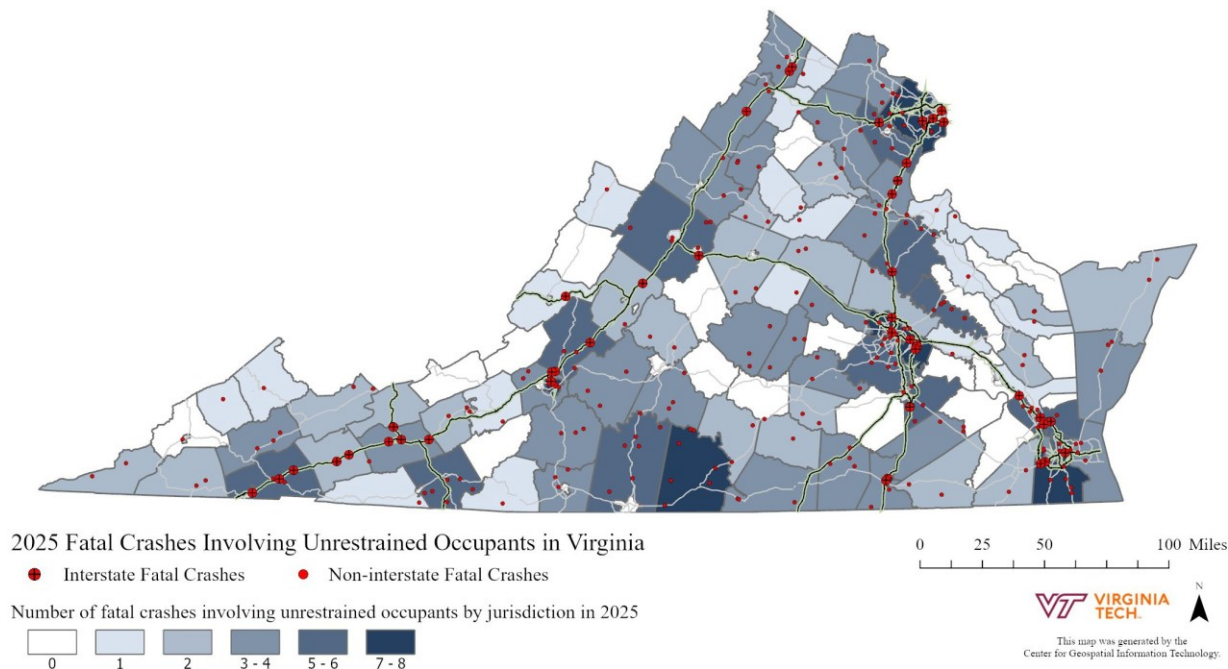

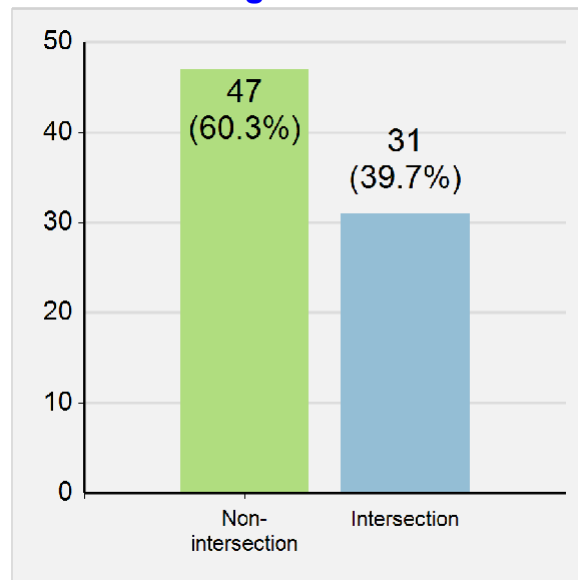

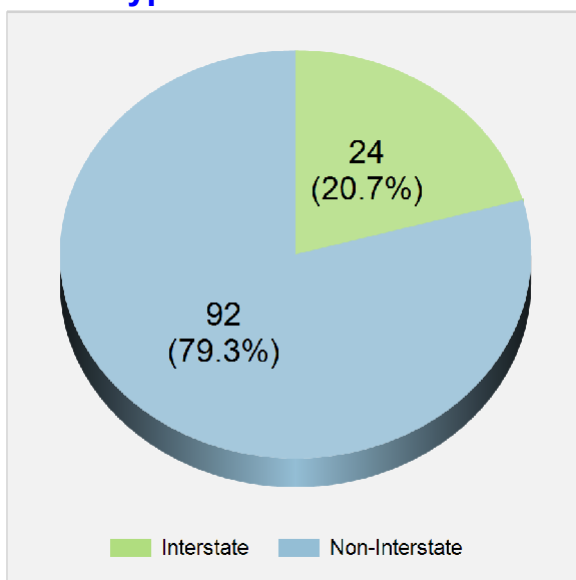

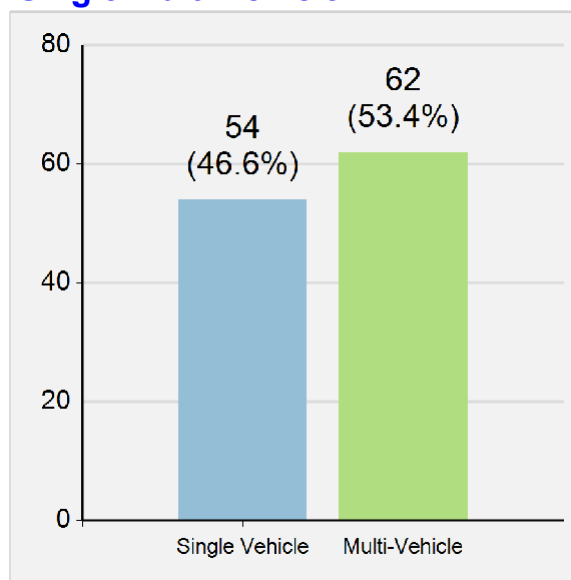

Distracted Driving Fatalities by Single/Multi Vehicle



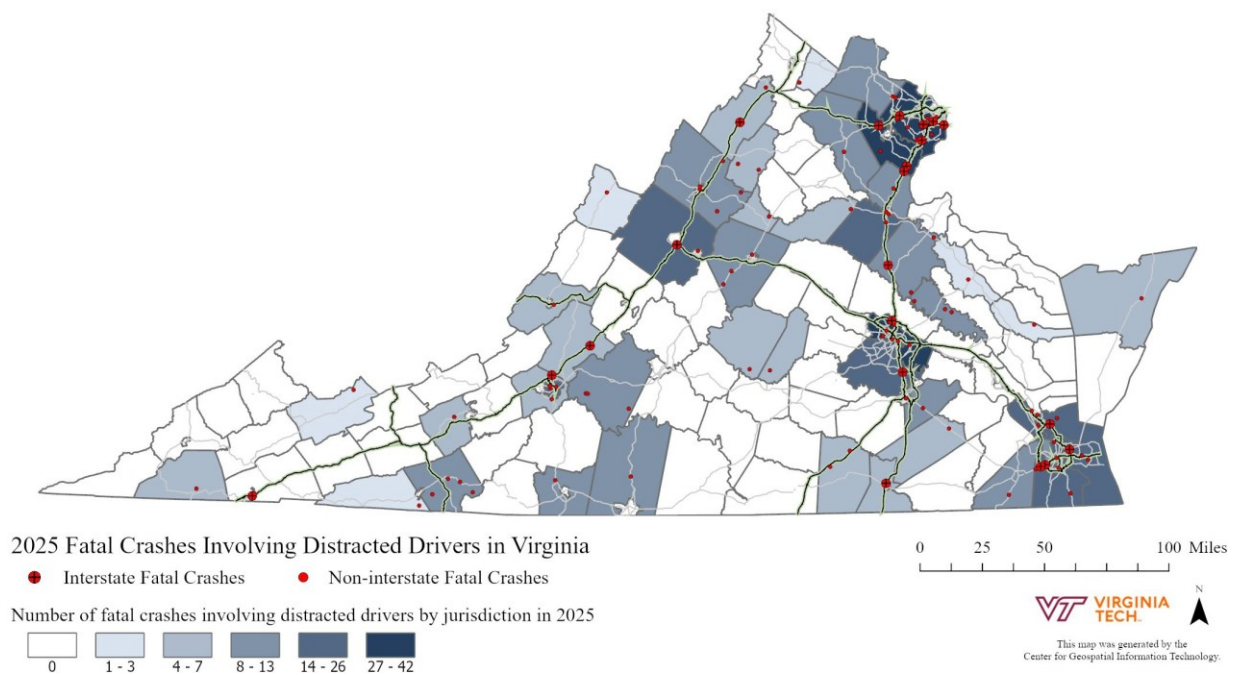

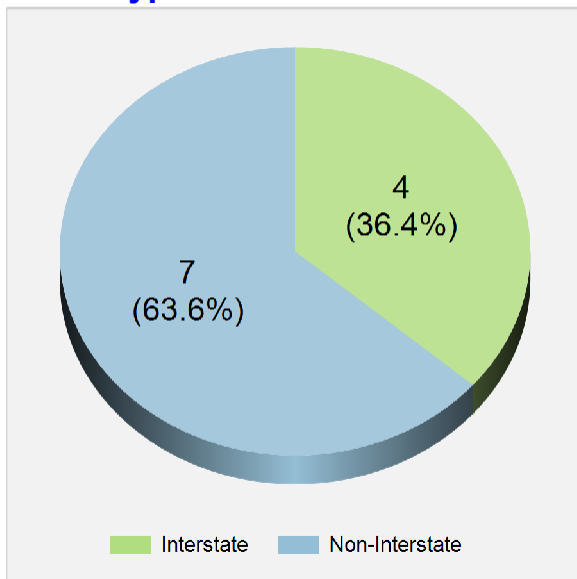

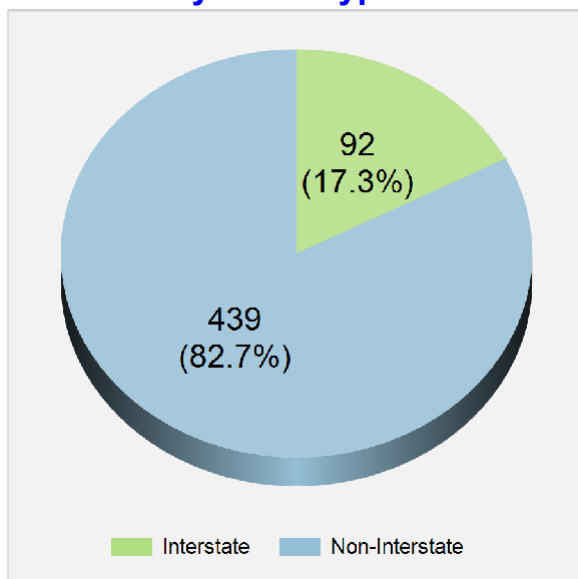

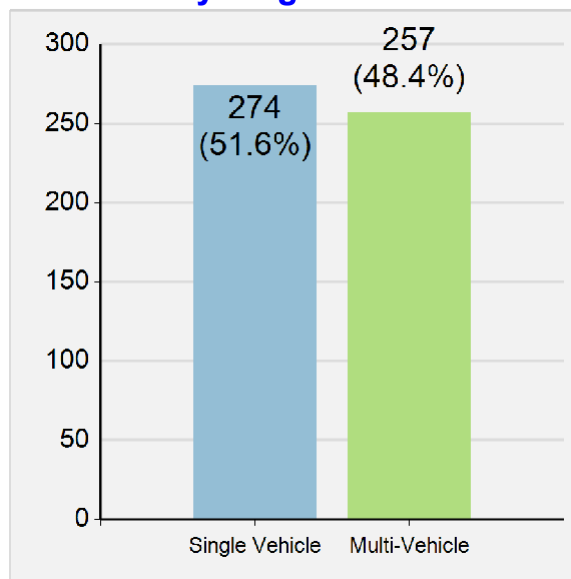

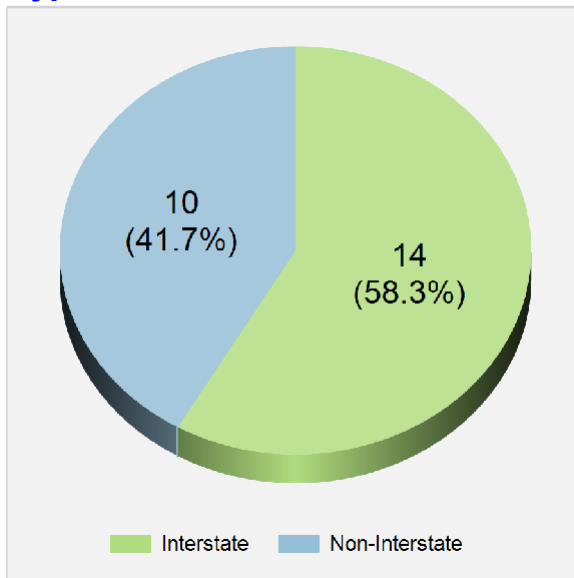

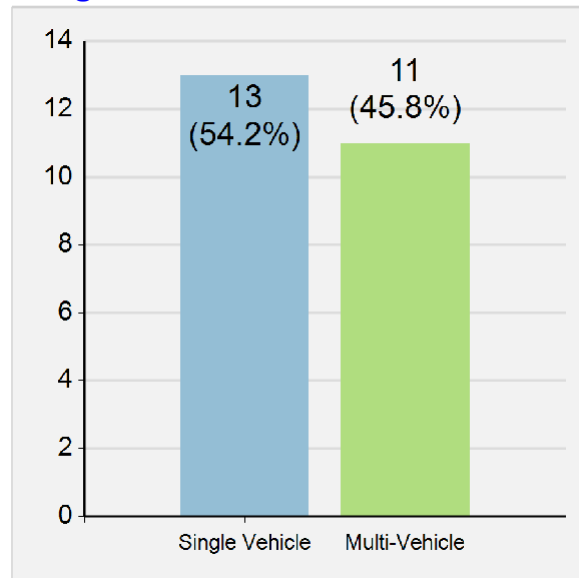

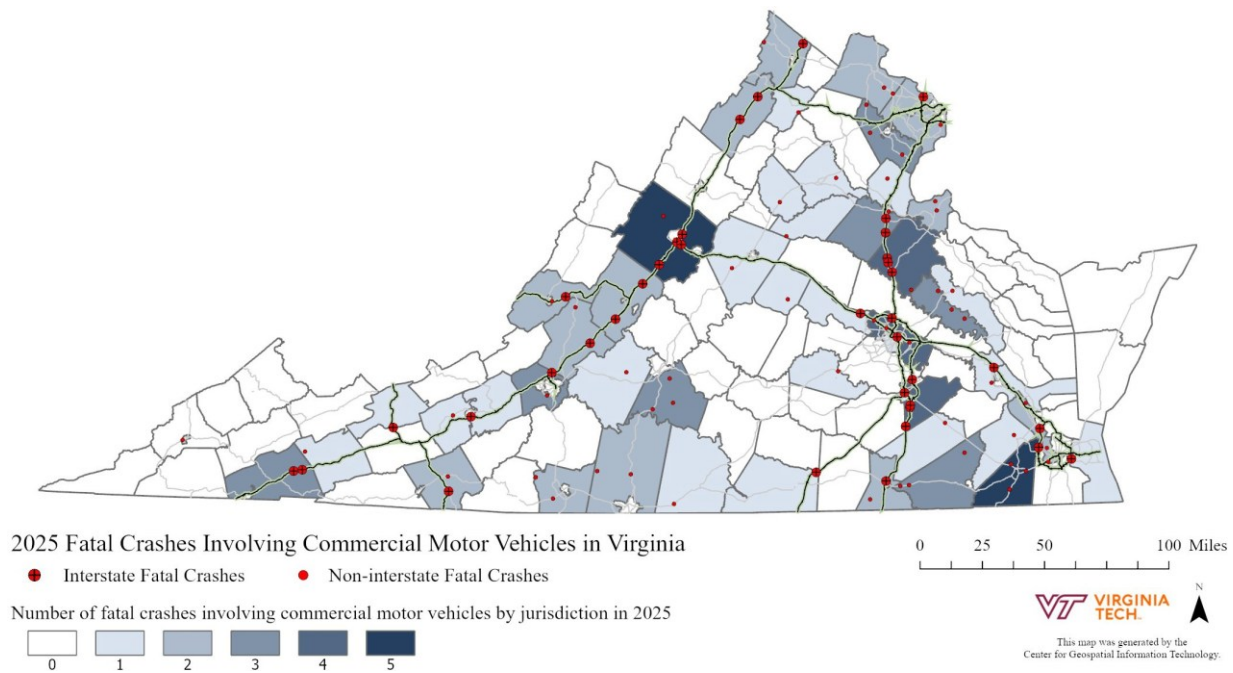

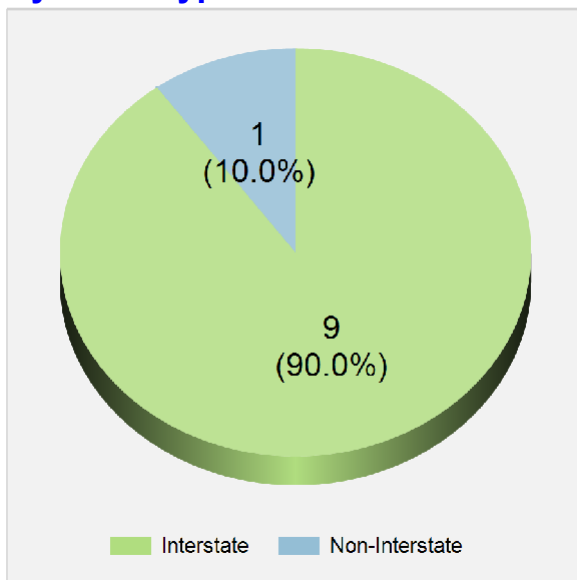

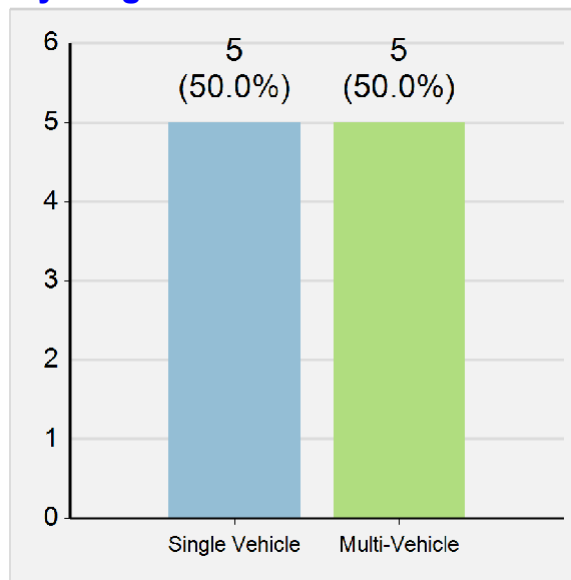

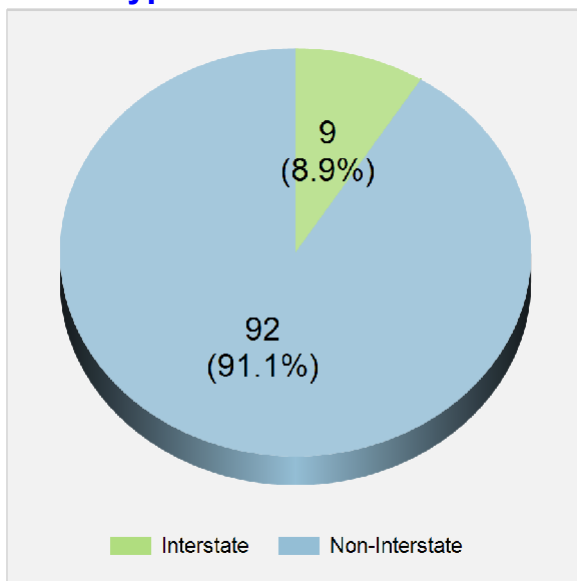

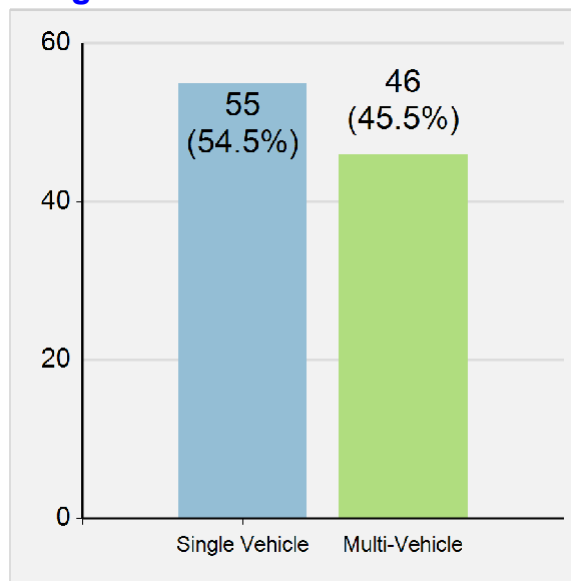

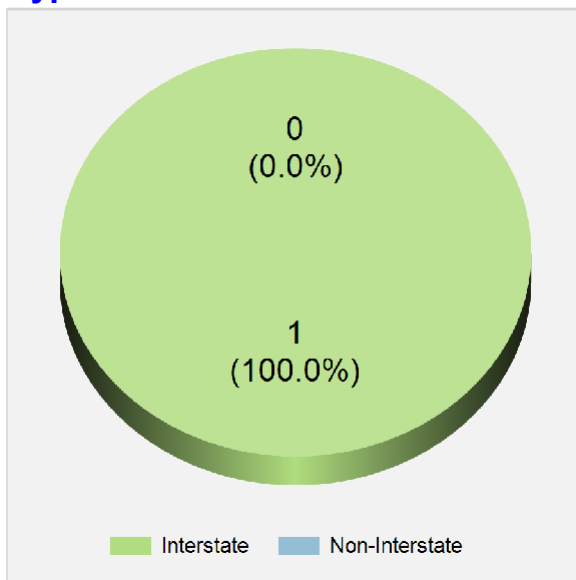

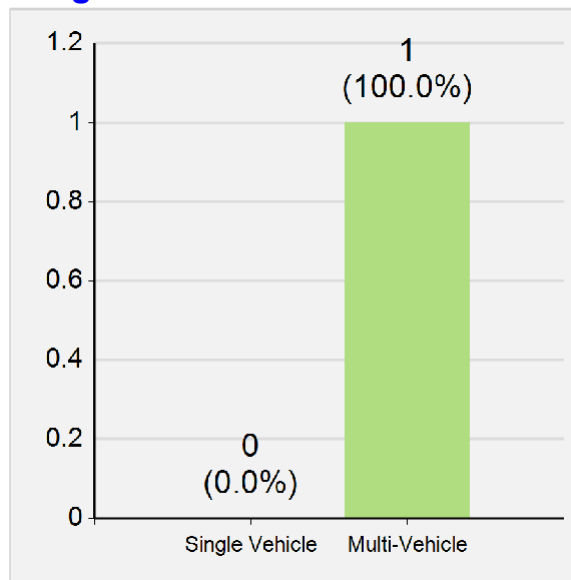

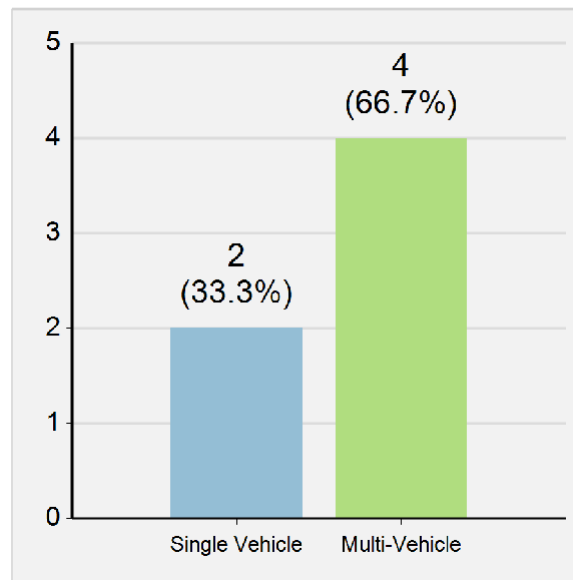

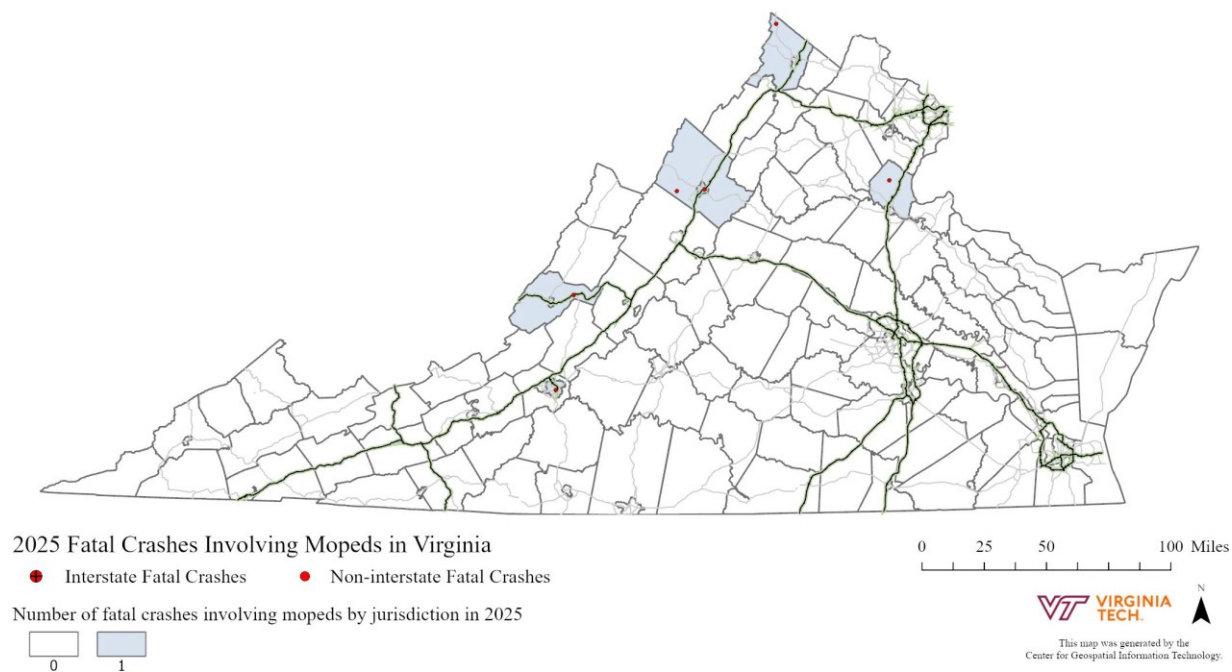

Term	Description
Alcohol-Related Crash	Crash where a driver or pedestrian is listed on the police report as drinking before the crash. BAC data (0.01 or greater) is used in addition to police reports to determine alcohol-related status.
Alcohol-Related Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash involving alcohol.
Alcohol-Related Injury	Person who is injured as a result of a traffic crash involving alcohol.
Bicycle Crash	Crash that involves at least one bicycle and one or more motor vehicles.
Bicycle Fatality	Bicycle rider who dies within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash.
Bicycle Injury	Bicycle rider who was injured as a result of a traffic crash.
Bus Crash	Crash that involves a city transit bus, privately owned church bus, or a commercial bus.
Bus Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash involving a bus.
Bus Injury	Person who is injured as a result of a traffic crash involving a bus.
Cell Phone Driver Crash	Crash that involves a driver who was talking (not texting) on a cell phone at the time of the crash.
Cell Phone Driver Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a cell phone driver crash.
Cell Phone Driver Injury	Person who is injured as a result of a cell phone driver crash.
Commercial Motor Vehicle (FMSCA Reportable) Crash	Crash that involves at least one vehicle categorized as a commercial motor vehicle by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA). Such a vehicle: (1) has a gross vehicle weight rating or gross combination weight rating of 10,001 pounds or more; or (2) is designed or used to transport 9 or more people; or (3) is displaying a hazardous materials placard; AND the crash results in: (1) a fatality; or (2) an injury; or (3) a disabled vehicle that requires transport away from the scene.
Commercial Motor Vehicle (FMSCA Reportable) Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash involving at least one vehicle categorized as a commercial motor vehicle by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).
Commercial Motor Vehicle (FMSCA Reportable) Injury	Person who is injured within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash involving at least one vehicle categorized as a commercial motor vehicle by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).
Distracted Driver Crash	Crash that involves at least one distracted driver.
Distracted Driver Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a distracted driver traffic crash.
Distracted Driver Injury	Person who is injured as a result of a distracted driver traffic crash.
Fatal Crash	Crash that results in one or more fatalities.
Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash.
Large Truck (Driver) Crash	Crash that involves at least one driver of a large truck (tractor trailer, semi or double).
Large Truck (Driver) Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a large truck (tractor trailer, semi or double) related traffic crash.
Large Truck (Driver) Injury (Tractor Trailer, Semi or Double)	Person who is injured as a result of a large truck (tractor trailer, semi or double) related traffic crash.
Mature Driver Crash (Age 65 & Older)	Crash that involves at least one mature driver.
Mature Driver Fatality (Age 65 & Older)	Mature driver who dies within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash.

Moped Crash	Crash that involves at least one moped.

Motorcycle Crash	Crash that involves at least one motorcycle.
Motorcycle Fatality	Motorcycle rider who dies within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash.
Motorcycle Injury	Motorcycle rider who is injured as a result of a traffic crash.
Passenger Vehicle Crash	Crash that involves a passenger car, pickup/passenger truck, van, or sport utility vehicle (SUV).
Passenger Vehicle Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a passenger vehicle crash.
Passenger Vehicle Injury	Person who is injured as a result of a passenger vehicle crash.
Pedestrian Crash	Crash that involves at least one pedestrian and one or more motor vehicles.
Pedestrian Fatality	Pedestrian who dies within 30 days as a result of traffic crash.
Pedestrian Injury	Pedestrian who is injured as a result of a traffic crash.
Personal Injury Crash	Crash which results in no fatalities but one or more persons are injured.
Property Damage Crash	Crash which results in no fatalities or injuries, but there is property damage of at least \$1,500.
Reportable Traffic Crash	Crash on a public highway which involves death, injury or property damage in excess of \$1,500.
School Bus Crash	Crash that involves a school bus.
School Bus Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a school bus crash.
School Bus Injury	Person who is injured as a result of a school bus crash.
Speed-Related Crash	Crash that involves a driver exceeding the posted speed limit or driving too fast for conditions.
Speed-Related Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of traffic crash involving excessive speed.
Speed-Related Injury	Person who is injured as a result of traffic crash involving excessive speed.
Teen Driver Crash (Ages 15-19)	Crash that involves at least one teen driver.
Teen Driver Fatality (Ages 15-19)	Teen driver who dies within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash.
Teen Driver Injury (Ages 15-19)	Teen driver who is injured as a result of a traffic crash.
Texting Driver Crash	Crash that involves a driver who was texting (not talking) on a cell phone at the time of the crash.
Texting Driver Fatality	Person who dies within 30 days as a result of a texting driver crash.
Texting Driver Injury	Person who is injured as a result of a texting driver crash.
Unrestrained Crash	Crash that involves at least one unrestrained person killed or injured in a vehicle equipped with safety restraints.
Unrestrained Fatality	Unrestrained person who dies within 30 days as a result of a traffic crash in vehicle equipped with safety restraint.
Unrestrained Injury	Unrestrained person who is injured as a result of a traffic crash in vehicle equipped with safety restraints.
Vehicle Equipped with Safety Restraints	For “Annual Crash Facts” reports, any of the following vehicles are considered vehicles with safety restraints: Passenger car; truck – pickup/passenger truck; van; truck – single unit truck (2 axle); motor home/recreational vehicle; emergency vehicle (regardless of vehicle type); truck – sport utility vehicle (SUV); truck – single unit truck (3 axles or more); truck – truck tractor (bobtail – no trailer).
